



STEWART FAMILY RESERVE PINOT NOIR | 2023

Built on a legacy of quality and consistency, our Stewart Family Reserve wines are produced from some of the best and oldest vineyards in the Okanagan Valley. A gracious and welcoming legacy continues through this collection with benchmark expressions of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

2023 VINTAGE

The 2023 vintage was brimming with both challenge and reward. We faced unseasonably cold winter conditions followed by record levels of Okanagan sunshine, resulting in a small but quality crop and the earliest harvest in Quails' Gate history.

WINEMAKING

This vintage is made from a blend of our premium Pinot Noir blocks and clones grown at our West Kelowna estate. Some of the vines date back to the 1990's, giving this wine it's exceptional fruit complexity. The fruit was hand-picked, destemmed and transferred into stainless steel tanks where it was fermented on skins. After 14-16 days on skins, the wine was aged for 14 months in a combination of 33% new and 67% neutral French oak.

TASTING NOTES

Elegant and inviting, the aromas of violet and clove lead into a palate of ripe black cherry framed by soft velvety tannin. Perfectly balanced between bright acidity and rounded texture, with warming flavours of baking spice concluding the lengthy finish.

PERFECT PAIRINGS

Showcasing the complexity of Pinot Noir, this wine has ample freshness to pair with rich dishes like seared duck breast, mushroom agnolotti, or bold cheese such as Manchego or mature Gouda.
